

These auction lots are from a different donor. Bidding will start at \$1 for each lot.

Adelaide Community Weavers.














The stamps are contained in a folder, this is the outer cover. Scan at 90%.




The stamps from the six nations are inside in a folder. Shown at 50%. This is a classy presentation, and a must for collectors of nature, animals, birds, or environmental issues.




**Lot 17** - two small Chinese stockbooks, full with stamps featuring trains and locomotives, and everything railway related. Great range of countries. **Lot 18** - First of three foolscap or folio size folders, with home made pages featuring stamps of non-issuing countries, such as MANAMA, RAS AL KHAIMA, UMM AL QIWAIN, FUJEIRA, and a few others such as ALBANIA and DUBAI. All are bright and colourful stamps and minisheets.

- **Lot 19** similar to Lot 18, except most of these are from countries which issue legitimate stamps. Has more stamps than the previous lot.

- Lot 21 Australia Post yearbook 1986, still in the original plastic.
- **Lot 22** range of 1938 cinderella stamps. All are mint unhinged, although some have stuck together. Careful peeling may reward.



**Lot 23** - Photograph album in a sliver cardboard box. The pages in the photo album are black, unused, and are spiral bound so they open flat. Ideal for a stamp album, although there are no replacement pages or extra pages available. Scan below at 75%.





Photo album, scan at 75%.

## T.105 The Handicapped of China

Since the founding of New China, the state has showed great concern over the social welfare services of the handicappet. In order to reflect the socialst spiritual civilization and modilize the entire/society to raise funds for the welfare services, of the handicapped, the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications of the People's Republic of China issued on March 15, 1985 a set of four semi-postal stamps entitled "The Handicapped of China" (TI05) in colour photogravure. Size: 31 × 38.5 mm.
