Lot 1 - Lolly tin with Australian stamps on paper, few KGV but all seem to be average used. Reserve \$1.



Lot 2 - Lolly tin with stamps on paper, mostly overseas. Reserve \$1.



Lot 3 - 3 Post Office Packs and a minisheet, as shown. Reserve \$1.



Lot 4 - few Australian stamps on paper, recent issues. Reserve \$1.



Lot 5 - set of 5 special booklets produced by Australia Post for the Bicentenary, with the stamps inside the covers. Seems never to have been opened. Includes the brown slipcase. Reserve \$1.



Lot 6 - brand new stamp album, dating from the 1980s, still in the plastic wrapper, although now torn. Lovely book. Reserve \$10.
