Thie first part of our December auction features some used kangaroo and map stamps, used on old album pages as donated to our society. These are sold 'as is', as I have not checked any watermarks. Note that lots 1 to 9 include large and small OS perfins.

All scans are at actual size, scanned at 300dpi so you can enlarge the images. Front view of specimen stamps (lot 11) scanned at 600dpi. The colours are fairly accurate.

Lot 1 - half penny green 'kangaroo and map' stamps. Reserve \$1.





Lot 2 - two pages of one penny red 'kangaroo and map' stamps. Shades not checked. Reserve \$1.

Lot 4 - two pence half penny dark blue 'kangaroo and map' stamps. The perf large OS is a difficult stamp if genuine, and this page has a nice range of shades. Reserve \$1.

Lot 6 - page with four copies of the four pence orange & yellow 'kangaroo and map' stamps, and three copies of the five pence brown. Reserve \$1.



Lot 7 - three pages of sixpence blue and sixpence brown 'kangaroo and map' issues, shown in this and the next page. Reserve 1.



Lot 7 continued. The third page has only two stamps on it. Both stamps (OS overprint and OS perfin) are small multiple watermark.




Lot 8 - page with nine pence violet 'kangaroo and map' stamps, watermarks not checked.

Lot 9 - one shi9lling emerald green 'kangaroo and map' stamp, again nice range of shades and both perf OS. Watermarks not checked. Reserve \$1.






Lot 10 - page of two shillings brown and red brown 'kangaroo and map' stamps. Reserve \$1.

Lot 11 - three 'kangaroo and map' type D specimen stamps. These are CofA watermark. Note ten shillings stamp is creased, has dirt on back (pencil marks?), other two stamps have minor creasing. Have full perfs, but all are off centre. Reserve \$20.



Lot 12 - Opening of the new Parliament House in Canberra in 1927, Australia's first commemorative stamp. The value is in the block of four cancelled on the day of issue, and the perf OS only obtainable in specimen packs. Reserve \$1.




Lot 13 - Issue to commemorate the flights of Charles Kingsford-Smith, and to highlight air mail services. Set of three stamps with a brown airmail stamp with a similar design. Six pence violet stamp seems to be mint (stuck down onto page), and OS overprints are very fine used (no gum). Reserve \$5.

Lot 14 - Sturt set. Top two stamps have no gum, but are very fine used from a specimen set. The perf OS are particularly nice, but are stuck down. Reserve \$1.



Lot 15 - Sydney Harbour Bridge set, over two pages. Both printings of the 2d red, one 3d blue is a private perfin (poor), the five shillings appears to have been used to pay bulk postage or maybe a parcel or telegram. Violet ink is uncommon, and was never used on mail because it could be washed off easily, allowing the stamp to be used again. The OS overprints are nice, and postally used. They appear to be genuine. Reserve \$50.










Lot 16 - Gibraltar, 54 stamps on pages, all stamps have been used and hinged, reserve \$1.
