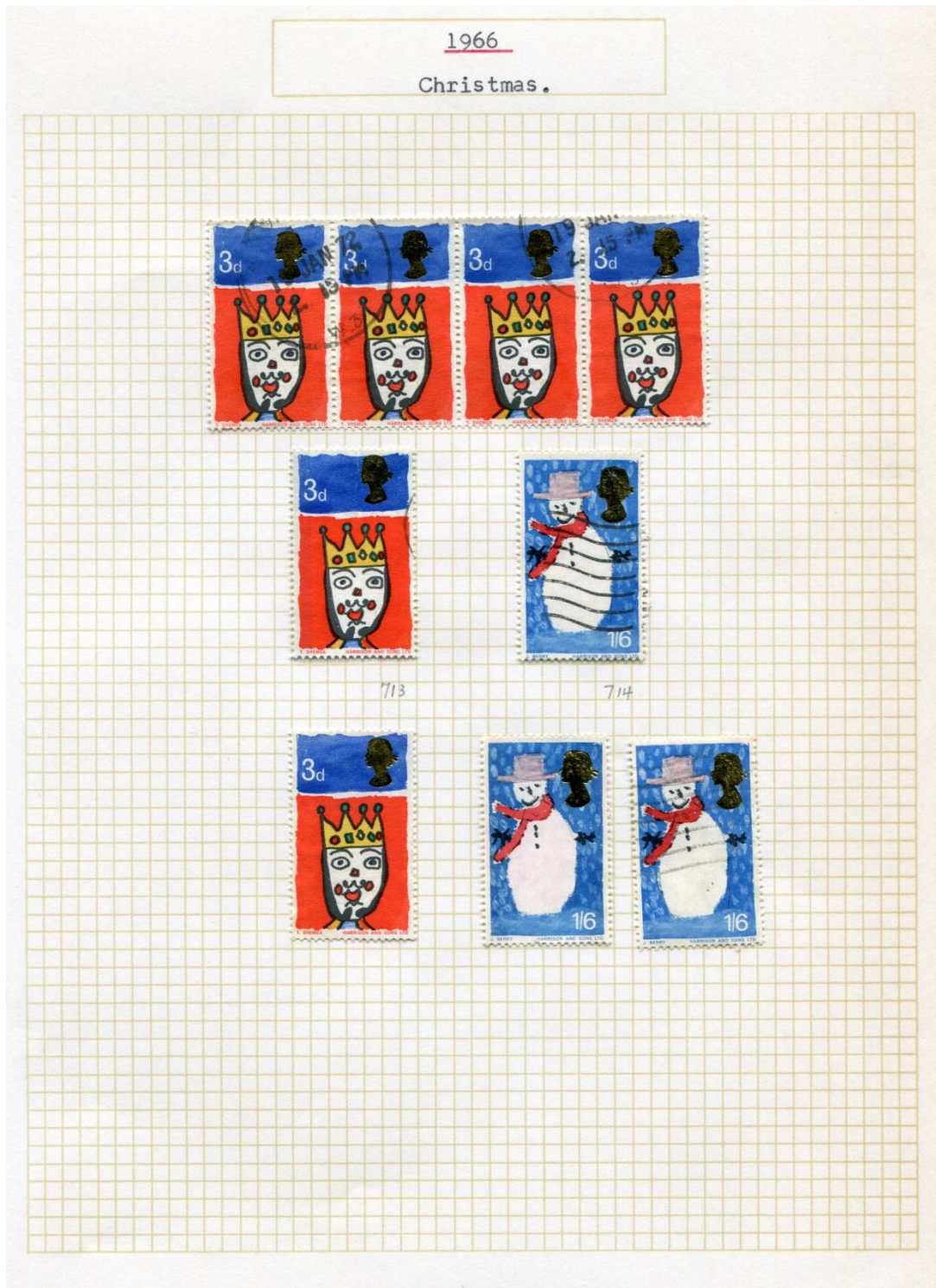

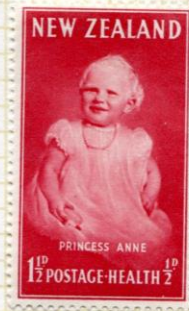

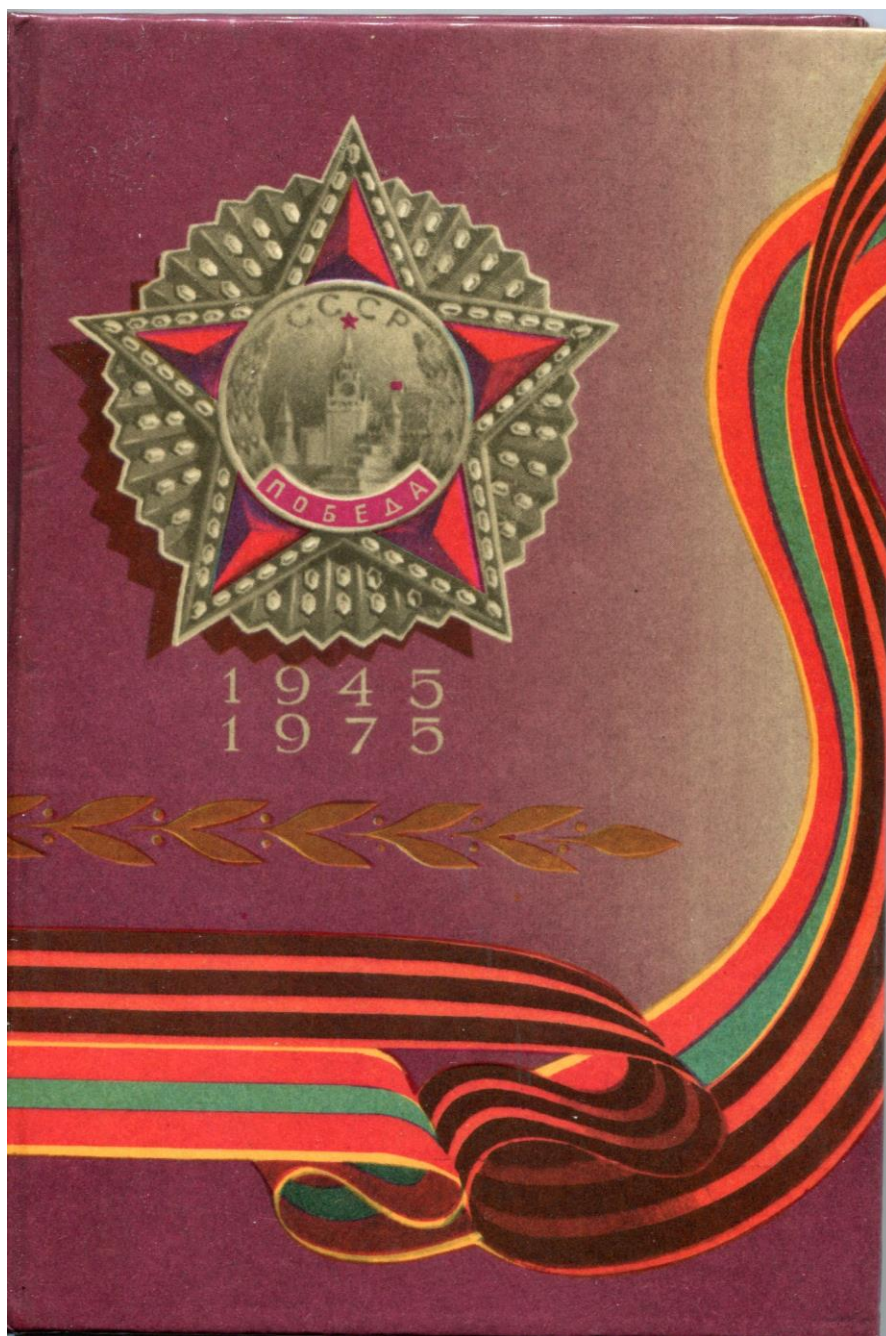

Lot 31, inside of folder scanned at 100%.



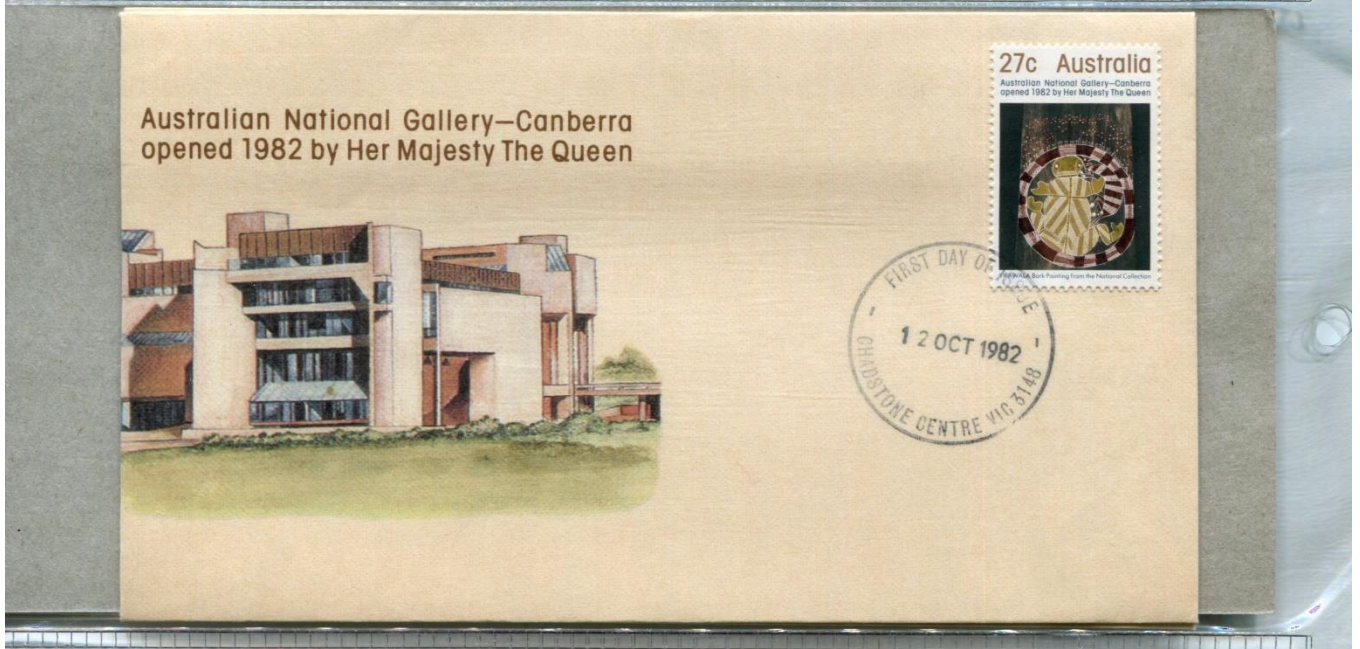
Lot 32 - another small stiff folder, this one with stamps of Cuba. Two scans, reserve \$1.

All the others are first day covers from Christmas 1974 to 1985, probably not complete. Plus a few stamp packs with stamps enclosed. One scan, reserve \$1.



Lot 34 - old style photograph album, with 3 ring binder mechanism, and 'magnetic' pages covered with tissue paper so not to damage the covers. Contains collection of Australian pre-stamped envelopes all cancelled first day of issue. Probably not complete. Neat and tidy. From 1979 to 1989, one scan, reserve \$1.
