
Lot 11 - This lot has five pages. Page 1 below contains 5 kangaroo stamps, appear to be small multi watermark, page 2 has eleven KGV issues seem to be all CofA watermarks, the brown pair is mint. Page 3 has five 3d blue kookas, one with the red exhibition cancel. Page4 (not scanned) has four 3d green airmail stamps, while page 5 (not scanned) has one used 1929 WA centenary and a strip of 3 mint stamps. Reserve \$5.








Lot 12 - this lot has 4 pages. The first page, scanned below, has stamps commemorating the centenary of Victoria, with more stamps on page 2. Page 3 scanned on the next page has stamps commemorating John Macarthur and the Aust wool industry, page 4 not scanned has six of the Hermes airmail stamps, with the watermark and paper variations. Reserve \$5.





Lot 13 - this lot has 5 pages. Page 1 has the 6d large brown kooka (shown below), then page two has five stamps of the one shillings lyrebird, one overprint OS, one perf VG, page 3 has the 1935 Anzac issue and the KGV jubilee issues, page 4 has the 1936 commemoratives, and page5 has a set of the 1938 NSW150th anniversary. 






Lot 14 - seven pages of boring KGVI definitive stamps, two pages scanned. Reserve \$1.






Lot 15 - military themed stamps, imprint blocks of the 1940 forces set, and some BCOF overprints. Three pages, each page scanned. Reserve \$2.










