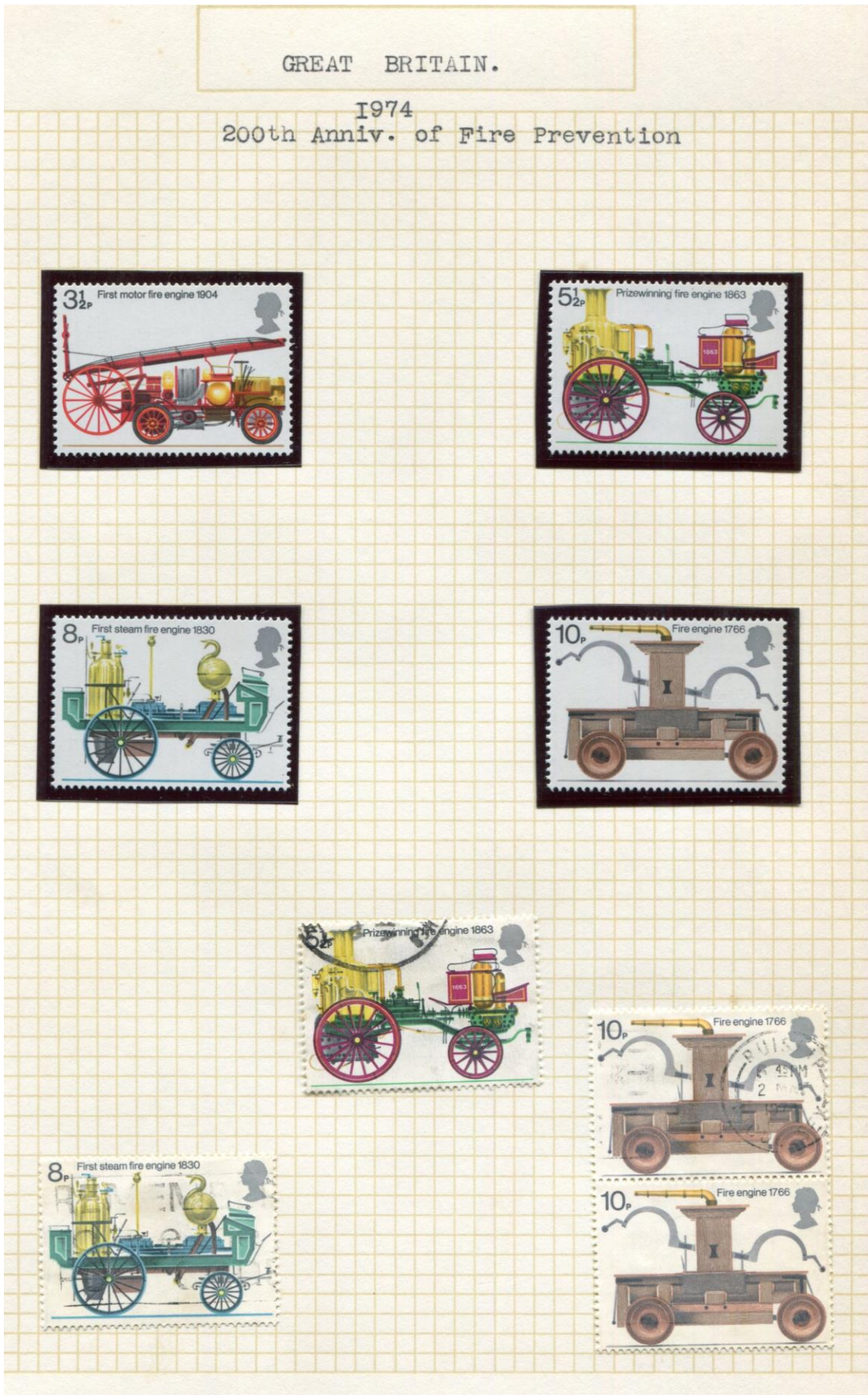

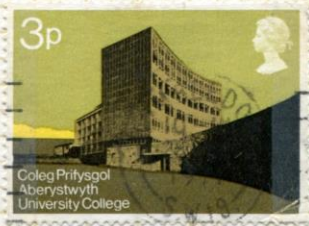
Lot 25 - Collection of Great Britain, mint and used, from 1970 to 1979. Mostly mint, with some used with some sets. Reserve \$5.
