The bottom stamps inscribed VALENCIA are Spanish stamps used to find a building program.



Lot 3 - group containing three packets of stamps (two scanned below) and an old Embassy (aka Woolworths) stamp album. Contains a few sets, nothing special. Two scans, bidding from \$1.

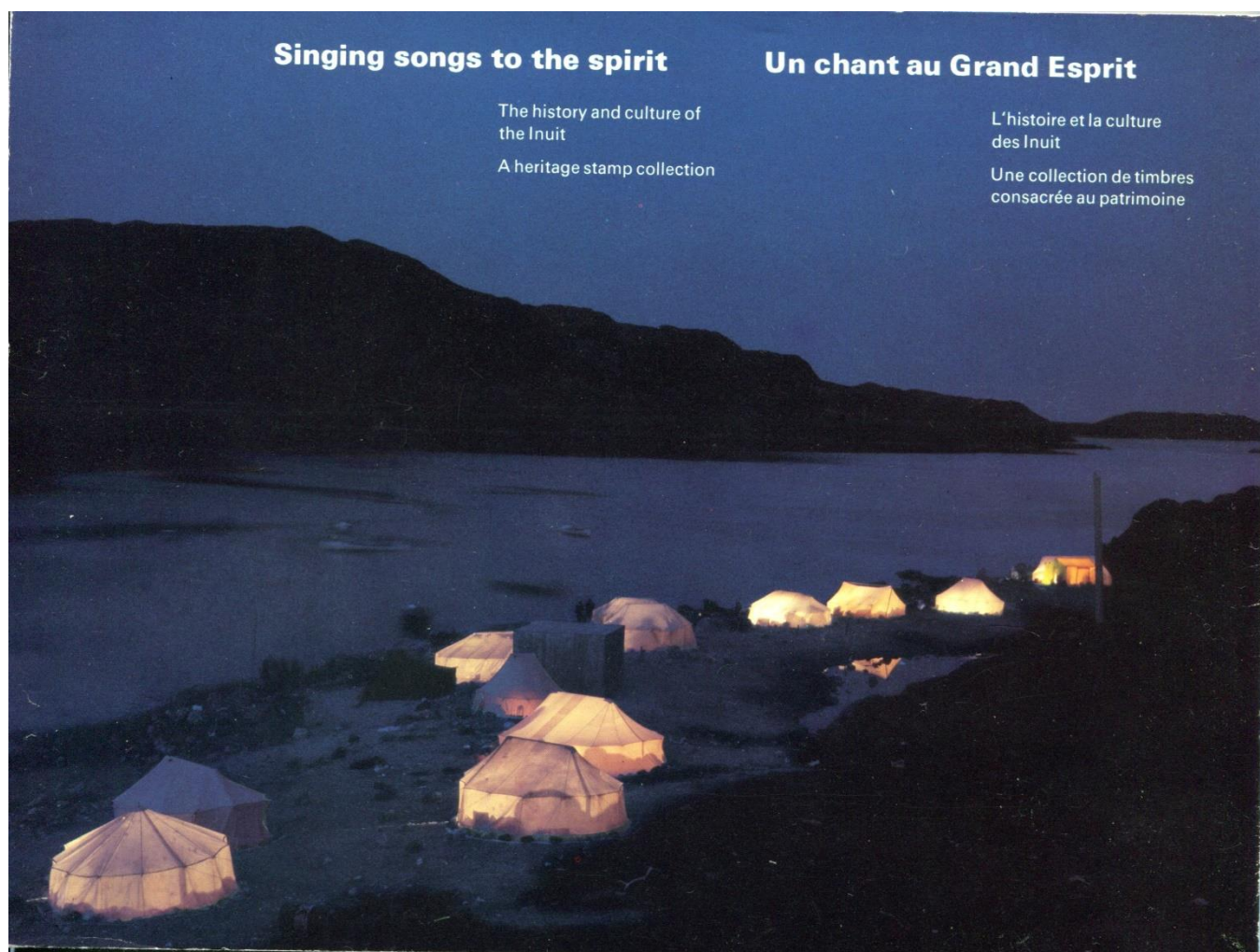

Lot 6 - black covered spring back folder with used stamps of Australia, strength lies in QEII pre-decimal and decimal stamps (to mid 1970s). Not all singles, contains many blocks. Just this one scan that is representative of all pages, bidding from \$10.

Lot 7 - another black spring back binder, all mint stamps mostly in blocks. A little bit of toning here and there, large blocks are scarce. Just one scan, bidding from \$10.
